





The Experience

Tapping on the link would show a short summary from the introduction section of a Wikipedia article.
















Multi language support

- Download
 - o npm install wikipedia-preview
- Load on content pages
- Activate on content pages
 - o <script>wikipediaPreview.init({options})</script>



Usage (editors)

- Enable Wikipedia Preview on a specific word or HTML element
 - < Cat
- Or have it automatically enabled for Wikipedia links
 - o Cat
